

Procedures for safe housekeeping


Be careful with blood!

DISINFECTING when there's blood:

1. Wear disposable gloves.
2. Wipe up all visible blood with a paper towel.
3. Disinfect with a mix of water and bleach, and let it sit for 10 minutes.
4. Rinse the surface using a wet paper towels and let dry.
5. Put the paper towels and gloves in a plastic bag and close it well.
6. Put the plastic bag out with the garbage.
7. Wash your hands.

Be careful!

Blood and blood-stained fluids can contain viruses. Some viruses even survive in dried blood!



Preparing the water and bleach mix

- Mix 1 part bleach with 9 parts water.
- Keep the mix in an opaque bottle (e.g. empty bleach bottle) for 24 hours maximum.
- When mixing a new batch, label the bottle "Water and bleach mix" and include the date on which it was prepared.

Caution: Some surfaces or objects could be damaged by bleach. Follow the manufacturer's instructions.
